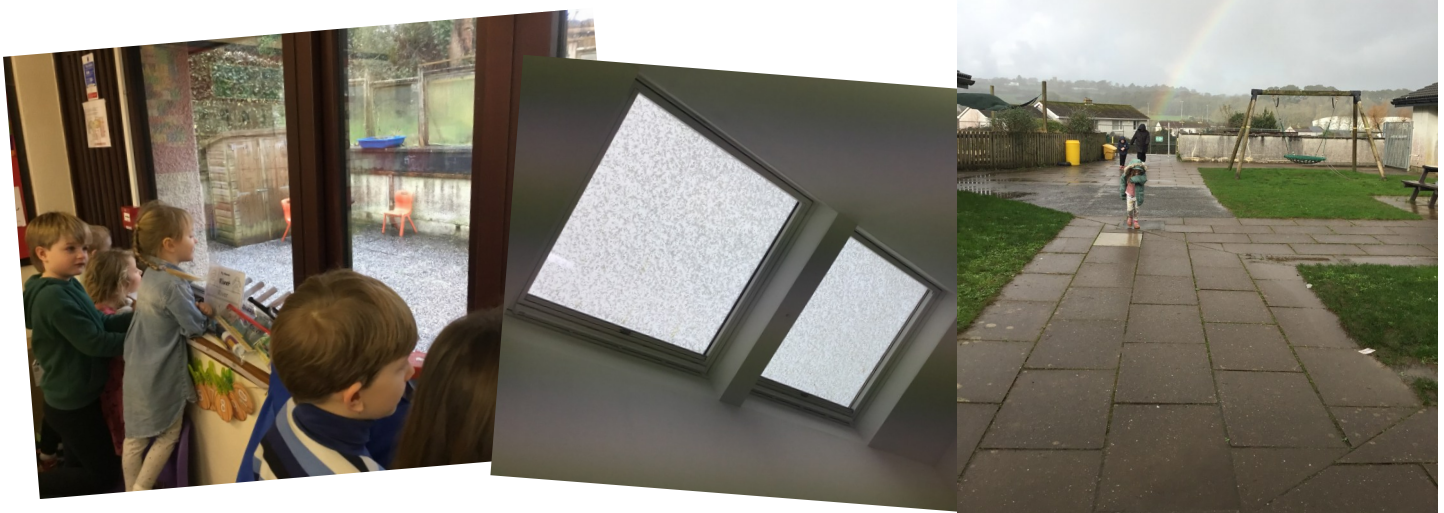
Chinese New Year Race

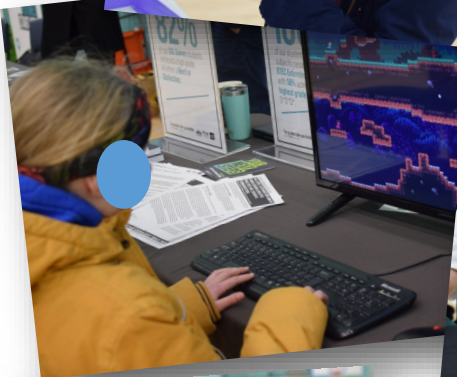


Future Pathways:
